Opt In Support to find work

Many disabled people and people with health conditions want to work, and want support to do this.

Opt In provides extra help to people who get Supported Living Payment and want to get a job, do some training, or study. It is aimed at people aged from 16 to 29 years and is being trialled in 22 centres around New Zealand.

Many disabled people and people with health conditions work, and enjoy the rewards it provides.

If you are interested in working, training or studying, talk to us to see if you are able to join *Opt In* or to find out about the other ways Work and Income can help you.

Opt In – support to find work

If you decide to take part you will work closely with a Work and Income case manager who has experience in working with disabled people and people with health conditions looking for work.

You may already have a clear idea of what you would like to do and how to get there, or your case manager can assist with ideas on training, study or finding a job that will suit you. This could include looking at whether any special arrangements or equipment are needed.

You choose who else will be involved

You can decide who else you would like to be involved in helping you reach your work goals. It might be your family, a support person and others you work with.

We will work together so we know what you already have in place. We will also see if there are other organisations that could help you reach your goals.

Opt In and your benefit

Joining *Opt In* is your choice, and you can stop at any time. If you find work your case manager will talk about how this income may affect your benefit.

When you are getting Supported Living Payment you do not have to look for work. *Opt In* is completely voluntary and your benefit won't be affected if you decide not to join.
