A new disability support system: Mana Whaikaha



This is an **Easy Read** letter about the **new** disability support system.



The Government will have a new way of giving disability support in the area where you live.



The new disability support system is going to be called **Mana**Whaikaha.





The new system will start on **1 October 2018**.



It will start in the MidCentral District Health Board region.

The MidCentral DHB region includes:



- Palmerston North
- Horowhenua
- Manawatu
- Ōtaki
- Tararua districts.



You will be in the new system because you:

- use disability support services funding
- live in MidCentral.



The new system will give you more:

- choices about your life
- control of your disability support.





What will happen from 1 October 2018?



 You will keep getting disability support.



2. You can ask to **make changes** to the disability support you are getting.



3. You will be contacted by us at your **review** time.

The **review** is when we meet with you to talk about:



- the support you are getting now
- how well these supports are working for you.



The review is also about:

- what changes you may need to your supports
- what you will be able to do in this new system.



Before the changes to the system you talked to people from **Enable NASC**.





From 1 October 2018 you will talk to people from Mana
Whaikaha.





A Connector is someone who will work with:




- disabled people

You **do not** have to have a Connector if you do not want to.




